Start here: [Mission Brief](#) — it tells you what you are signing up for.

Before the event: [Saber Craft](#) — the chapter that matters at hour two.

Everything in between is your build, in order. Take it one section at a time.



READ ME FIRST

This is a field manual, not a novel — you are not meant to read it front to back. Jump to the station you need:

RIGHT NOW Mission Brief + The Jedi Code.

BEFORE BUYING The Complete Parts List — order everything in one batch; shipping is the bottleneck.

WHILE BUILDING Work the build chapters in order; each one is a station, not a lecture.

BEFORE THE EVENT Game Day — the only chapter that matters at hour two.

RUNNING LATE? Open the companion WEEK-BY-WEEK calendar and jump to your current week.

■ ONE SITTING RULE

Read Mission Brief + The Jedi Code today. Everything else waits until its week.



PICK YOUR BAR

*Same hero, three finish lines. Pick yours now so you don't over- or under-build. The same build can be finished to three different bars — pick yours **now**, because builders who polish for the wrong one burn weeks.*

LEAN · €70-150

Trick-or-Treat

Bought cloth set, any blue saber. Episode III, no armor. Reads as Anakin at a glance — perfect for a first Halloween.

EFFORT · ~5 hrs

MID · €150-300

Convention

Nicer tunic plus the free printed pauldron + gauntlets (Clone Wars look). Most builders land here.

EFFORT · ~20 hrs

REBEL LEGION · €300-450+

Screen-Accurate

Sewn navy + maroon, full Ahsoka armor incl. chest plate, metal-hilt blue saber. The lifetime piece.

EFFORT · 40+ hrs



THE FALLBACK PLAN

*A first-time build of this suit is **10–120 hrs** of hands-on work across **1–8 weeks**. Life happens — so decide right now what gets cut when the clock wins. Finished beats perfect.*

BEHIND EARLY Drop first: Reference & Fit. Nobody will notice at 5m.

BEHIND LATE Simplify next: Hair & Scar, Trousers — buy instead of make, or borrow.

EMERGENCY Every printed part has a buy option. Switching one part to bought can save a whole week.

ALWAYS The final week is for wearing it, not building it — dress rehearsal beats one more coat of paint.

🕒 THE HONEST RULE

If a piece is not started two weeks before the event, it is not in this year's costume. Build it for the next one.



THE COUNTDOWN

The whole plan on one page — tick the boxes as the weeks fall. The full week-by-week calendar is a separate companion PDF.

Weeks 8–7 ☐ Plan + order everything

Weeks 6–5 ☐ First fit + hem robe

Weeks 4–3 ☐ Saber to blue + layer drill

Week 2 ☐ Glove · scar · hair

Week 1 ☐ Dress rehearsal · game day



MISSION BRIEF

*This builds **Anakin Skywalker** three ways — Episode III robes, Clone Wars, and the Ahsoka flashback look. Pick a look with the toggle above the Forge; the full PDF covers all three.*

Episode III is all **cloth, leather, and a blue blade** — no printing, doable in a weekend. The Clone Wars and Ahsoka looks add 3D-printed armour (pauldron, gauntlets, chest plate). Same robe base, blue blade for all three.

The Big Idea

- ▶ Jedi = **Rebel Legion** (heroes). Villains = 501st.
- ▶ Mostly buy or sew. The only "hard" part is the saber — and you can buy that.
- ▶ Blade is **blue**.

This manual builds Anakin Skywalker — three different ways, in one book. All three looks share the same blue blade; they differ in colours and in how much armor you add. Pick one before you buy anything — it sets your colours, your hair, and how much printing you'll do.

WHICH CLUB?

Jedi costumes belong to the Rebel Legion — the heroes' costuming club — not the 501st. Their Anakin standards are linked in Manufacturing Files.



THE JEDI CODE

Every Jedi learns the Code — five lines that keep you calm and centered. Anakin wrestled with it his whole life (that's his whole story), but a Jedi-in-training knows it by heart. Read it before you suit up.

THE JEDI CODE

There is no emotion, there is peace.
There is no ignorance, there is knowledge.
There is no passion, there is serenity.
There is no chaos, there is harmony.
There is no death, there is the Force.

The Builder's Code (For the Workshop)

- ▶ There is no panic, there is a checklist.
- ▶ There is no guessing, there is a test print.
- ▶ There is no glue where there could be magnets.
- ▶ There is no rushing, there is the 90-minute test wear.
- ▶ There is no red blade — there is blue.

One code for the con, one for the workbench. Recite accordingly.



PROCUREMENT ROSTER

Three paths: **(A)** buy a full set, **(B)** buy pieces, **(C)** sew it. Most do B.

Path A · Buy the Whole Set

Full "Anakin ROTS Jedi" costumes ship from China for about **€42–60**. Costume-grade, great for a first Halloween.

Path B · Taobao Pieces

- ▶ Tunic — 绝地武士 服装 棉麻 棕色
- ▶ Robe — 绝地武士 斗篷 连帽 棕色
- ▶ Belt — 绝地 腰带 真皮 棕色
- ▶ Boots — 棕色 高筒靴
- ▶ Glove (1) — 黑色 皮手套 单只

Path C · Sew It

Deep-brown cotton/linen + a free Jedi tunic pattern. Most accurate, most work.

FREE ARMOUR FILES · CLONE WARS & AHSOKA

Anakin's Pauldron by Bugman_140 (Printables 68631) is a free STL of the exact left-shoulder armour — child + adult sizes, with slots for two 10×10×5 mm magnets so it snaps onto your sleeve. Armatus Designs' free Jedi Cosplay Gauntlets (Printables 1403127) are magnetized too, in several sizes. Magnets beat glue: the armour snaps on, comes off for the car, and survives bumps.

More search terms: navy CW/Ahsoka tunic — 安纳金 克隆战争 服装 深蓝 · armor kit — 安纳金 肩甲 护臂 cosplay. Paste the Chinese into Taobao, or use English on AliExpress / eBay.



ROBES & TUNIC

Layered right, even cheap pieces read "Jedi" instantly.

Layer Order (skin → out)

- ▶ 1 · Under-tunic (cream)
- ▶ 2 · Outer tunic (deep brown, crosses over)
- ▶ 3 · Tabards (long panels, front & back)
- ▶ 4 · Obi / sash
- ▶ 5 · Belt over the obi
- ▶ 6 · Robe on top

ROBE LENGTH

Hem ~5 cm off the floor — long, but won't catch on stairs.

The robe/cloak is optional — Anakin often leaves it off in battle scenes, so don't panic if it isn't ready. If you wear it: hem it so it ends about 5 cm (2 inches) off the floor — long, but safe on stairs.



THE ARMOR (3D PRINTED)

Episode III skips this whole section — it's all cloth. The Clone Wars and Ahsoka looks add armor: a pauldron (left shoulder), gauntlets (forearms), and — for Ahsoka — a chest plate. Anakin was a Jedi General who led clone troopers in the Clone Wars — hence the armor. The shoulder file is FREE.

THE FREE PAULDRON — START HERE

Anakin's Pauldron by Bugman_140 on Printables (model 68631) is a free STL of the exact left-shoulder armor. It comes in a small (child) and large (adult) size — print the small one. It has slots for two 10×10×5 mm magnets so it snaps onto your sleeve. The pauldron is small — print it first as your test piece to prove your settings before the chest plate.

The Pauldron

One curved plate over the LEFT shoulder. Print the child size, finish it (see Finishing the Armor), and attach with two magnets — one inside the tunic shoulder, one in the armor — so it snaps on and off, comes off for the car, and survives bumps. Magnets beat glue.

The Gauntlets

Forearm armor on both arms. There's a FREE file — Armatus Designs' "Jedi Cosplay Gauntlets (Clone Wars)" on Printables — magnetized, with several sizes and a split version for small printers. Finish them the same dark grey as the pauldron.

The Chest Plate (Ahsoka only)

The live-action flashback adds a chest/shoulder plate over the tunic. It's a bigger print — do it last. Clone Wars (animated) skips it. Armor snaps on last, over the belted tunic; Clone Wars and Ahsoka Anakin often fight with the robe off so the armor shows — bring it for a dramatic entrance or leave it off.

DON'T WANT TO PRINT IT?

Ready-made kits exist — search "Anakin Clone Wars / Ahsoka shoulder & chest armor kit" with magnetic openings on Etsy and cosplay sites. Costs more than printing but zero sanding.



FINISHING THE ARMOR

Episode III builders can skip this — no armor to finish. A fresh print has visible layer lines and feels rough. "Finishing" turns a plastic print into screen armor — the same routine the Vader manual uses. If you've never done it, here is every step and exactly what to buy.

What You'll Buy

- ▶ Sandpaper — a multi-grit pack: 120 / 240 / 320 / 400 / 600.
- ▶ Filler primer (grey rattle can) — Rust-Oleum or Tamiya; thick spray that fills tiny lines.
- ▶ Spray paint, dark grey — the base colour of the armor.
- ▶ Black acrylic (small pot) — for the "dirty" wash in the grooves.
- ▶ Silver acrylic (small pot) — for scuffed-metal edges.
- ▶ Spot filler / putty — only if a part printed in pieces.
- ▶ Satin clear coat spray, a respirator/dust mask, painter's tape.

Sanding = rubbing off printer ridges. Priming = a base spray that fills the last tiny lines and helps colour stick. A wash = watered-down dark paint that runs into grooves to make detail pop. Weathering = fake scuffs so the armor looks used, not new.

1 · Sand	120 grit, then 240, then 400 — each pass removes the last one's scratches.
2 · Fill seams	Glue multi-part prints, fill the join with putty, cure overnight, sand flat.
3 · Wipe clean	Damp cloth, then dry fully — no dust.
4 · Filler primer	Spray a coat, let dry, wet-sand 320 grit (a little water, in circles). Repeat once.
5 · Base coat	Dark grey spray, 2 thin coats, ~20 min apart.
6 · Wash	Water down black acrylic, brush into grooves, wipe the flats.
7 · Scuffs	Dry-brush a little silver on edges for battle-worn metal.
8 · Clear coat	One light satin coat to seal. Done.

SPRAY SAFETY

Spray outside or in an open garage only — never indoors. Wear the mask, keep away from flames. Sanding dust isn't good to breathe either, so mask up for that too. Under 18? Have an adult with you.



THE LIGHTSABER

Anakin's blade is **blue**. Four ways to get one.

THE EASY ANSWER

A blue neopixel saber is the simplest option. Already own a saber? Just set it to BLUE — one saber covers every look.

The Paths

- ▶ **A · Print a hilt** — CaseStudyno8 (1538383) or infinati (321812).
- ▶ **B · Cheap LED saber** — Taobao 光剑 蓝色, €40–120.
- ▶ **C · Neopixel** — bright blue, sound, clash. Best value.
- ▶ **D · Premium** — screen-accurate metal hilt, €100–400+.

Approval: metal hilt, blue blade, one silver + one copper button, Graflex emitter, covertec wheel.



THE GLOVE & HERO DETAILS

The touches that say "Anakin," not "a Jedi."

ONE GLOVE

Black leather glove on the RIGHT hand only — the mechno-hand. Left hand bare.

Scar & Hair

- ▶ Thin scar over the **right eye** — subtle line, not a gash.
- ▶ Shoulder-length hair swept back; clean-shaven for ROTS.



BUILD SEQUENCE

Fast, because there's nothing to print or paint.

- ▶ **1 • Order** tunic, robe, belt, boots, saber (or set any saber you own to blue). Order early.
- ▶ **2 • Fit & hem** robe to ~5 cm off floor; sleeves to the wrist.
- ▶ **3 • Layer & belt** — practice the order; obi + belt snug.
- ▶ **4 • Details** — glove, scar, hair. Light the blade blue. Done.

90-MINUTE RULE

Do a full 90-minute test wear at home first.

Armor Track (Clone Wars & Ahsoka Only)

The armor track runs in parallel — start the prints day one so they run while you sort the cloth.

- ▶ A • Download & start prints: free pauldron (child size) + gauntlets (+ chest plate for Ahsoka).
- ▶ B • Finish the armor: sand, prime, paint dark grey, weather, clear coat.
- ▶ C • Add magnets to the pauldron, elastic to the gauntlets.
- ▶ D • Snap the armor on last, over the belted tunic.

Armored-look kit extras: spare magnets, a glue stick, and elastic. Pop the pauldron off between photos if you need a break — that's what the magnets are for.

SIZING THE ARMOR

Most cosplay armor is modeled for adults. The free pauldron has a child size built in — use it. For other files, scale to ~80–85% in your slicer and test-print a small section first.



GAME DAY

Robes are warm — great for a cold Halloween.

- ▶ Saber charged and BLUE; robe hemmed; glove on the right hand.
- ▶ Kit: safety pins (tabards slip), spare glove, blade batteries.
- ▶ Watch the hem on stairs. Take the robe off between photos indoors to stay cool.

● ● MORE GAME DAY LINES

- ▶ “I don't like sand. It's coarse and rough and irritating, and it gets everywhere.” — *totally serious face — sandbox and beach approved*
- ▶ “Now THIS is podracing!” — *yell it any time you go fast*
- ▶ “You underestimate my power!” — *point dramatically — bonus points on any high ground*

😄 FOR LAUGHS — KID EDITION

- ▶ I don't like glitter. It's coarse and rough and irritating, and it gets everywhere.
- ▶ Now THIS is carpool racing!
- ▶ You underestimate my snack power.



MEETING YOUR FANS

Half the magic of a costume is what you say when someone walks up. Here are in-character lines ready to go — gentle ones for little kids, and bigger ones for older fans and photos.

GOLDEN RULE — READ THE ROOM

Heroes get mobbed by little fans — lean into it. Kneel to their height, keep it warm, and let them feel like part of the adventure.

For Little Kids — Kind and Playful

- ▶ "I built droids when I was your age — you can build amazing things too!"
- ▶ "Want to see a Jedi flip? Okay, I'll just imagine it for now."
- ▶ "Being scared is okay. Being brave anyway is the Jedi way."

Big and In-Character — Older Fans and Photos

- ▶ "This is where the fun begins."
- ▶ "I'm good at building things — and at winning."
- ▶ "I sense great things in your future."

Universal tips for meeting young fans: kneel to their eye level, never break character to correct them, ask their name and make them the hero, and if a prop weapon is involved keep it lowered and pointed away. The goal is simple — every kid walks away thinking they just met the real one.

Posture for photos: Anakin is intense. Blue blade lit, slight scowl, blade held low and angled across the body. A billowing robe adds drama.



BUILDER TIPS

"A Jedi's strength flows from a belt that actually stays up."

- ▶ Obi + belt hold everything together — get them snug.
- ▶ One glove, right hand only.
- ▶ Blue, not red — double-check before you leave.
- ▶ Keep boots and belt the same brown family.



VARIANT REFERENCE

Pick an era before you build.

- ▶ **Ep I** — kid, simple tan tunic. Easiest.
- ▶ **Ep II** — Padawan braid, dark tunic.
- ▶ **Ep III** — full Knight: robes, tabards, right glove, scar, blue blade. No armour.
- ▶ **Clone Wars** — darker robes + printed pauldron & gauntlets.
- ▶ **Ahsoka** — navy/maroon + pauldron, gauntlets & chest plate.

NO BRAID

Ep III Anakin is a Knight — no Padawan braid.

Advanced · Knightfall & the World Between Worlds

Two advanced looks for when your base Anakin is done. **Knightfall** — the Episode III robes with yellow Sith eyes and a cold, blank stare (no scars yet — it's before the burns). A ring of yellow-and-red eyeshadow reads as "Sith eyes" safely; contacts only with adult + eye-care professional help. **The Cracked Helmet** — half a Vader helmet with a jagged, foam-built broken edge over pale scarred makeup and one yellow eye. Half hero, half machine — "there's still good in him."

Upgrade Path

The blue saber, brown leather belt, tall boots, single right-hand glove and robe/tunic base are shared by all three looks — build Episode III first, then add printed armor later without starting over. Level up: print the pauldron + gauntlets and darken the tunic for Clone Wars; add the chest plate and swap to navy + maroon for Ahsoka.

COLOUR CHEAT-SHEET

Ep III: deep brown tunic (cotton/linen, not shiny), cream under-tunic, mahogany trousers. Clone Wars: dark blue / near-black tunic, grey armor. Ahsoka: navy microsuede tunic over maroon under-layers, dark grey weathered armor. Brown belt & boots for all. Scar: clear in Ep III; faint or not yet in Clone Wars / early Ahsoka.



KNIGHTFALL & THE WORLD BETWEEN WORLDS

The advanced Anakin — the moment he stops being only Anakin and starts becoming Vader. Two related looks, both about the man and the monster as one. They take more makeup and prop work than the three main looks, so try them once you've built a base Anakin you're happy with.

| Knightfall — The Jedi Who Fell

Anakin in his Jedi robes during the march on the Jedi Temple. Start from the Episode III look you already know — brown robes, the single glove, the blue saber — and change just two things: the eyes and the attitude. He still looks like a Jedi; the change is in the eyes and the cold expression. No scars yet — Knightfall is before the burns. Hood up for the dramatic entrance, then back to show the eyes.

THE YELLOW SITH EYES — WITH CARE

The fall shows in the eyes: a ring of yellow-orange with a red rim. Best for kids: skip contacts — a ring of yellow and red eyeshadow with a little dark shading reads as "Sith eyes" in photos. Costume contacts only with an adult and an eye-care professional who fits them to you. Never share lenses, never sleep in them, never use cheap unfitted ones.

| The Cracked Helmet — World Between Worlds

The showpiece: one side Anakin's face, the other Vader's shattered helmet, as if the mask broke to reveal the man inside. Print just the left half of a Vader helmet, or build the broken edge from craft foam so it looks shattered, not neatly sliced — jagged, with a little silver on the rim to read as bent metal. Your own face shows through the open side: pale base blended at the helmet edge, scars built with skin-safe products only (stylised, not gruesome), and the one yellow eye. Patch-test every product on a small patch of skin 24 hours early — if it gets itchy or red, stop and wash it off. Check you can see on the helmet side (tinted mesh in the eye socket) and that nothing presses on your face.

READ THE ROOM

This look is powerful and a little eerie — perfect for older fans and photos, but it can spook little kids. If a small one looks unsure, turn the Anakin side toward them, smile, and say something kind. The whole idea is "there's still good in him" — let that show.



GLOSSARY

- ▶ **Rebel Legion** — heroes' costume club (Jedi/rebels).
- ▶ **Tunic** — the cross-over robe-shirt.
- ▶ **Tabard** — front/back hanging panels.
- ▶ **Obi** — wide waist sash.
- ▶ **Covertec wheel** — disc that clips the hilt to the belt.
- ▶ **Mechno-hand** — Anakin's robot right hand (→ the single glove).
- ▶ **Neopixel** — bright LED blade with sound.



WHY BUILD

Because before the mask, he was the hero everyone watched.

Vader is the hard-mode build — armour, paint, weeks of sanding. Anakin is the fabric-and-saber build you can finish in a weekend and grow into for years. Build one, or both, and switch sides with a button.

May the Force be with you. Always.



SABER CRAFT

The blade is half the costume — fight like the character. **Shien/Djem So**, wielded single.

FORM V · SHIEN/DJEM SO — “The Way of the Krayt Dragon”

Aggression with a rulebook — every block is the first half of a counterattack. Strong deflections that flow instantly into powerful cuts, always pressing forward, never conceding tempo. Djem So is the form of someone who believes the best defense is winning — which is Anakin in one sentence.

BLADE	● Blue
WIELD	single

Drill it

Counter-cut drill: block an imaginary diagonal strike, then immediately cut back along the exact same line as one single beat — block-and-answer, not block-then-answer. Ten reps per side.

△ DUEL SAFELY

Duel-grade polycarbonate blades only, never thin display tubes. Agree intensity before you start, no strikes to head or hands, and staff or dual spins need a full 3m of clear space.

COMPLETE PARTS LIST

Every piece referenced in this manual, grouped by where you get it. Shop in batches — fewer trips, fewer forgotten items.

PRINT THESE PARTS

Your 3D-printing queue. Test-print one piece before committing the whole suit.

- **Saber hilt (optional)** — Or buy a blue neopixel saber.

BUY THESE

Order all at once — shipping is the bottleneck.

- **Brown outer tunic** — Crosses over, ties under the obi.
- **Cream under-tunic** — Base layer.
- **Tabards + obi + belt** — Holds the tunic closed.
- **Brown trousers + tall boots** — Same colour family.
- **Black glove (1)** — Right hand only — the mechno-hand.
- **Brown hooded robe** — Hemmed ~5cm off the floor.
- **Blue lightsaber** — Set any saber to blue.



THE REPAIR KIT

Everything breaks at hour two. A sandwich bag with these seven things turns a costume emergency into a two-minute pit stop.

SUPER GLUE GEL Reattaches snapped prints and popped seams in 60 seconds. Gel doesn't run.

BLACK GAFFER TAPE Invisible on dark builds — holds a cracked plate through a whole event.

SAFETY PINS + VELCRO Instant strap repair, hem fix, cape re-hang.

ZIP TIES (BLACK) Broken buckle, loose greeble, sagging belt box — tie it and move on.

PAINT PEN (BLACK + SILVER) Covers scratches and scuffed edges between photos.

SPARE BATTERIES For LEDs and soundboards. The saber always dies at the door.

MICROFIBRE CLOTH Helmet fingerprints, lens fog, dusty boots.

PACK IT THE NIGHT BEFORE

One bag, one pocket (or a helper's backpack). If you have to go looking for glue, it is already too late.



Mid-build with painty fingers? This is the inside back cover index — every station and its page.
