🕒 YOUR FIRST WEEKS — WHERE MOST BUILDS DIE

Nearly every abandoned build dies in the first quarter: parts not ordered, printer not tested, nothing started. Win the first weeks — order everything, print one test piece — and the rest is downhill.



PICK YOUR BAR

*Three Jedi looks, one beard — here's how far you take the Negotiator. The same build can be finished to three different bars — pick yours **now**, because builders who polish for the wrong one burn weeks.*

LEAN · €60-110

Casual

Reads as Obi-Wan at 5m: layered cream tunics, a leather belt, and a trimmed beard sell it from across the hall. Skip the Clone Wars armour, fake the beard if you must, and run a cheap blue blade.

EFFORT · ~10 hrs

MID · €110-180

Convention

Reads as Obi-Wan at conversation distance: most builders land here with properly cut wool-blend tunic, vest and tabards, a real tooled-leather belt, and a groomed (or well-built) beard. A mid-tier hilt on a quick-draw clip seals the Jedi Master silhouette.

EFFORT · ~15 hrs

REBEL LEGION · €250+

Approved

Reads as Obi-Wan under inspection: screen-accuracy means correct fabric weights and colours, hand-finished tabards, an accurate aluminium hilt, and — for the Clone Wars look — a full set of painted clone armour over the robes. This is the lifetime piece a costuming club will stamp.

EFFORT · ~20 hrs



THE FALLBACK PLAN

*A first-time build of this suit is **10–20 hrs** of hands-on work across **4 weeks**. Life happens — so decide right now what gets cut when the clock wins. Finished beats perfect.*

BEHIND EARLY Drop first: Vambraces (CW only). Nobody will notice at 5m.

BEHIND LATE Simplify next: Clone Armour (CW only), Reference & Fit, Trousers — buy instead of make, or borrow.

EMERGENCY Every printed part has a buy option. Switching one part to bought can save a whole week.

ALWAYS The final week is for wearing it, not building it — dress rehearsal beats one more coat of paint.

🕒 THE HONEST RULE

If a piece is not started two weeks before the event, it is not in this year's costume. Build it for the next one.



PLAN + ORDER ROBES, BEARD, SABER

WEEKS 4-3

Plan + order robes, beard, saber.

PARTS IN PLAY THIS WEEK

CRITICAL Beard & Hair — ⌚ 1h · €15

No beard, no Obi-Wan.

HIGH Jedi Robe — ⌚ 2h · €45

Hem ~5cm off the floor.

PROGRESS · PHASE 1 OF 4 · 25% THROUGH THE PLAN



FIRST FIT + HEM; GET THE V-NECK VEST COLOUR RIGHT

WEEK 2

First fit + hem; get the V-neck vest colour right.

PARTS IN PLAY THIS WEEK

HIGHVest + Tabards — ⌚ 2h · €25

The V-neck vest colour marks the era.

PROGRESS · PHASE 2 OF 4 · 50% THROUGH THE PLAN



SABER TO BLUE; (CW) PAINT CLONE ARMOUR + TUCK SLEEVES

WEEK 1.5

Saber to blue; (CW) paint clone armour + tuck sleeves.

PARTS IN PLAY THIS WEEK

MEDIUM Clone Armour (CW only) — ⌚ 6h · €25

Switch to the Clone Wars look to use this.

CRITICAL Blue Lightsaber — ⌚ 2h · €60

Blue, not red. Set any saber to blue.

PROGRESS · PHASE 3 OF 4 · 75% THROUGH THE PLAN



DRESS REHEARSAL + GAME DAY

WEEK 1

Dress rehearsal + game day.

PROGRESS · PHASE 4 OF 4 · 100% THROUGH THE PLAN
