Week 1.5	PAINT – mask + paint in colour blocks; add graffiti tags last	.
Week 1	Clear coat + dress rehearsal + game day	.

🕒 YOUR FIRST WEEKS — WHERE MOST BUILDS DIE

Nearly every abandoned build dies in the first quarter: parts not ordered, printer not tested, nothing started. Win the first weeks — order everything, print one test piece — and the rest is downhill.



PICK YOUR BAR

*Same graffiti'd Mando armour, three ways to wear the paint. The same build can be finished to three different bars — pick yours **now**, because builders who polish for the wrong one burn weeks.*

LEAN · €160-230

Casual

Reads as Sabine at 5m: an orange flight suit, foam plates, and your own spray-can paint job carry the whole look. Skip the strap-fit fussing, run cheap twin pistols, and let bold colour blocks do the talking instead of fine detail.

EFFORT · ~30 hrs

MID · €240-330

Convention

Reads as Sabine at conversation distance: most builders land here with sanded EVA or resin plates, a sealed and weathered paint scheme, and a holstered belt that actually holds the pistols. Crisp graffiti motifs and a real flight suit sell it on the floor all day.

EFFORT · ~45 hrs

MANDO MERCS · €350+

Approved

Reads as Sabine under inspection: Mando Mercs CRL demands season-correct armour shapes, hand-painted graffiti matched to a specific episode, and a functional rangefinder helmet. Every plate is fibreglass or cold-cast, the flight suit is tailored, and the twin WESTAR pistols are screen-detailed.

EFFORT · ~60 hrs



THE FALLBACK PLAN

*A first-time build of this suit is **30–60 hrs** of hands-on work across **7 weeks**. Life happens — so decide right now what gets cut when the clock wins. Finished beats perfect.*

BEHIND EARLY Drop first: No Cape. Nobody will notice at 5m.

BEHIND LATE Simplify next: Reference & Fit, Boots — buy instead of make, or borrow.

EMERGENCY Every printed part has a buy option. Switching one part to bought can save a whole week.

ALWAYS The final week is for wearing it, not building it — dress rehearsal beats one more coat of paint.

🕒 THE HONEST RULE

If a piece is not started two weeks before the event, it is not in this year's costume. Build it for the next one.



PLAN + SKETCH THE PAINT SCHEME + ORDER FILAMENT, FLIGHT SUIT, TWIN BLASTERS

WEEKS 7-6

Plan + SKETCH the paint scheme + order filament, flight suit, twin blasters.

PARTS IN PLAY THIS WEEK

HIGHFlight Suit — ⌚ 2h · €30

Plain so the painted armour pops.

CRITICALTwin WESTAR-35 Blasters — ⌚ 3h · €35

Twin blasters are Sabine.

PROGRESS · PHASE 1 OF 5 · 20% THROUGH THE PLAN



PRINT ALL ARMOUR PARTS (PAINT LAST)

WEEKS 5 - 4

Print all armour parts (paint LAST).

PROGRESS · PHASE 2 OF 5 · 40% THROUGH THE PLAN



SAND GLASS-SMOOTH + PRIME EVERYTHING

WEEKS 3-2

Sand glass-smooth + prime EVERYTHING.

PROGRESS · PHASE 3 OF 5 · 60% THROUGH THE PLAN



PAINT — MASK + PAINT IN COLOUR BLOCKS; ADD GRAFFITI TAGS LAST

WEEK 1.5

PAINT — mask + paint in colour blocks; add graffiti tags last.

PROGRESS · PHASE 4 OF 5 · 80% THROUGH THE PLAN



CLEAR COAT + DRESS REHEARSAL + GAME DAY

WEEK 1

Clear coat + dress rehearsal + game day.

PROGRESS · PHASE 5 OF 5 · 100% THROUGH THE PLAN
